Purpose of Report	As per Section 10.1 of Purchasing By-law No. 061-2018, Council approval is required.	
Background information	The limited tendering category as defined within the Canadian Free Trade Agreement (CFTA) and Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA), captures a variety of award types including contract renewals, extensions, single or sole source and competitively bid. The awards are recommended to the vendors identified for reasons such as compatibility, existing enterprise application software's, joint government procurement initiatives and specialized/unique services or products. These awards are utilized mostly in areas such as information technology, fleet, traffic, transit or facilities systems. Staff are requesting a limited tendering designation for these suppliers and the ability to issue purchase orders for any requirements within the approved financial policies and the dollar thresholds identified in the attached schedule. These contracts are still being negotiated by staff and have been previously approved by Council on a limited tendering or competitive basis and the Schedule L attachment indicates the limited tendering request for 2025. *The Town is utilizing the Ministry of Ontario Vendor of Record (VOR) agreement (Tender-18677 - Mobile Devices and Services) with Rogers Communications Inc. awarded primary vendor status for procurement of Mobile Devices and Services. This agreement was established through a competitive bid process led by Supply Ontario and is set for an initial six-year term (2024 – 2030) with options existing to extend the agreement for 2 additional terms of 2 years each (4 additional years). The monthly pricing under this new agreement is more favorable than the Town's existing VOR contract (OSS-00415819) with Rogers. As existing cellular devices reach their renewal dates, they will automatically transition to the new agreement and the Town will benefit from the lower prices. Therefore, staff are seeking authority to sign an updated Master Adoption Agreement with Rogers Communications Inc. for the ongoing procurement of Mobile Devices and Services for an initial period of 6 years with the option to extend an additional 4 years, contingent upon Supply Ontario doing the same.

Further, staff are seeking authority to sign updated Master Agreements with Bell Canada and Telus Communications as required to fulfil obligations of secondary and tertiary ranked positions (within the VOR) where it is determined service coverage from the primary ranked vendor (Rogers Communications) is insufficient for ongoing Town needs.

	Rogers, Bell and Telus will continue to be included on annual limited tendering reports identifying estimated subsequent year annual spend amounts and be subject to ongoing Council approval.	
	**Staff recommends utilizing Canoe Purchasing Group of Canada (Canoe) for the provision of Fire safety equipment and gear. Canoe issued a competitive RFP, which resulted in an award to PPE Solutions Inc. (PPE) for a 4-year term ending March 27, 2028. The master agreement between Canoe and PPE provides a 10% to 35% discount off list price. The Town was successful in negotiating a 40.5% discount off list price directly with PPE. By leveraging the pricing under the Canoe master agreement the Town will benefit from the better discount.	
	***The Town has an agreement with Wilmac Co. for providing ongoing call recording software licensing and support for emergency fire dispatch operations. The average annual operating cost for this contract has been \$26,000. In 2025, the Town will need to perform a number of software and hardware upgrades to this system in support of establishing a fully equipped, redundant emergency communications and dispatching location for Milton Fire and Rescue Services. This is being done to ensure seamless integration with and operation alongside the required Next Generation 911 call handling solution implementation. These upgrades will result in a one-time (2025) increase in capital costs of \$375,736. Starting in 2026, the ongoing licensing and support costs is expected to revert to the standard operating expenses only.
