<b>Project Award</b>	Tender Award No. 25-01-00513 – Construction of 5 Side Road and Esquesing Line Intersection																	
<b>Recommendation</b>	<b>Staff is recommending that the tender for 5 Side Road and Esquesing Line be awarded to Pave-AI Limited in the total amount of \$1,737,290 (exclusive of HST) being the lowest compliant bid received.</b>																	
<b>Purpose of Report</b>	As per Section 10.1 of Purchasing By-law No. 061-2018, Council approval is required for tender awards over \$1,000,000.																	
<b>Background information</b>	<p>This capital project is for the construction of the 5 Side Road and Esquesing Line intersection bordering the Town of Milton and Halton Hills. As such, this project will be cost shared with Halton Hills on a 50% cost basis.</p> <p>A manual turning movement count completed in 2019 determined that warrants are met for the installation of traffic control signals at this intersection. As such, this capital project was identified in the Town’s capital forecast for design works to commence in 2023 with construction following.</p> <p>Construction will consist of culvert rehabilitation (damaged by the 2024 summer storm), installation of guiderail, replacement of asphalt wearing surface approaching and throughout intersection, installation of traffic control signals, and associated grading and landscaping.</p>
