

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON

BY-LAW NO. 091-2025

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 1984-1, AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE TRAFFIC AND PARKING ON HIGHWAYS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton deems it expedient to amend By-law No. 1984-1, as amended, being a By-law to regulate traffic and parking on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town of Milton;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Milton hereby enacts as follows:

1. **THAT** Part 1 - INTERPRETATION Section 1 Section (1) Definitions – introduce a – introduce a definition of a significant weather event as described as follows:

Significant weather event” means a period of time which the Town declares that it is anticipating a snow fall or ice accumulation which would require extensive maintenance.

2. **THAT** Part III – PARKING AND STOPPING Section 5 (2)(a)(x) PARKING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS be deleted
3. **THAT** Part III – PARKING AND STOPPING Section 5 (2)(b) PARKING AND STOPPING RESTRICTIONS be added:

No person shall park or stop a motor vehicle on any roadway when a significant weather event is declared.

4. **AND THAT** this By-law shall come into full force and effect when the appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.
5. **AND FURTHER THAT** all other provisions of By-law No. 1984-1, as amended, remain in full force and effect.

READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED this 8th day of September 2025.
