WHEREAS bicycle infrastructure is incorporated into all secondary plans, and its ultimate usability and connectivity is dependent upon the pace and timing of new development; and

WHEREAS in some instances, bicycle lanes are incorporated into new subdivisions where their functionality and usage are dependent upon adjacent and future development; and

WHEREAS exclusive use bicycle lanes have been installed on Bergamot Avenue to provide a future east-west cycling connection to the Milton Education Village (MEV); and

WHEREAS the critical mass of development to support cycling infrastructure associated with the MEV will take several years to be realized; and

WHEREAS Council previously directed a seasonal approach as an interim measure, whereby bicycle lanes on Bergamot Avenue are closed during the winter months to permit on-street parking, with the bicycle lanes reinstated in the spring and summer months; and

WHEREAS on-street parking and related seasonal restrictions in developing neighbourhoods have continued to create confusion and constraint for local residents; and

WHEREAS Council is seeking to achieve a balanced approach that supports both active transportation and the day-to-day needs of residents, including reasonable access to on-street parking without detriment to broader cycling connectivity; and

WHEREAS alternative cycling routes already provide a continuous and functional east-west connection from Tremaine Road to the Milton Education Village via Savoline Boulevard and Britannia Road—rendering reliance on Bergamot Avenue unnecessary for network continuity;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT staff be directed to remove the existing

exclusive-use bicycle lanes on Bergamot Avenue; and

THAT staff be directed to permit on-street parking on one side of Bergamot Avenue year-round, subject to the Town of Milton's standard on-street parking regulations, including maximum parking durations and winter maintenance requirements; and

THAT staff bring forward any necessary amendments to the Uniform Traffic Control By-law 1984-1 to implement this direction; and

THAT staff continue to enforce the Town of Milton's parking regulations, including maximum five-hour parking limits, no parking between 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., and restrictions related to snow removal.
